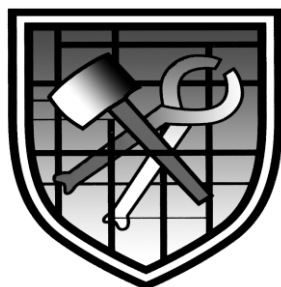

Parents will:
