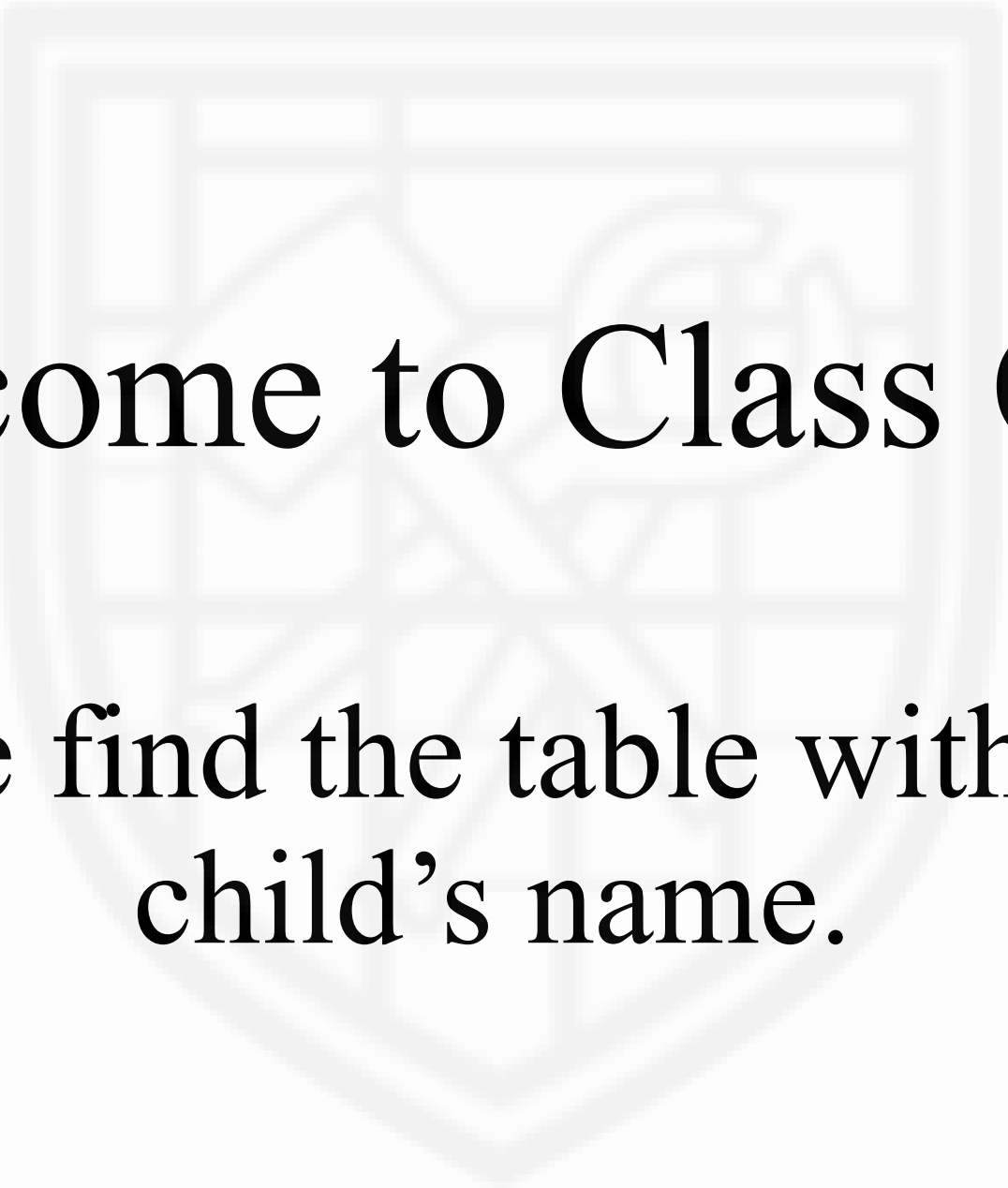

The School Day.

Meals.

PE days.

Reading.

We follow the Little Wandle reading scheme.

Children read three times a week with an adult and then bring their book home. They will bring a reading for pleasure book home also.

Reading.

Children should be reading daily at home with an adult which increases their confidence and fluency when reading.

Once a week, adults must record how many times children have read at home.

E.g. Read x5 times SMcE

Tricky Words.

On a Thursday, children's sight words/tricky words are tested.

They must be able to read all four or they will remain on that set of words.

Children will be given a log-in to Spelling Shed and they can access a list of words containing the tricky words being focused on for this week.

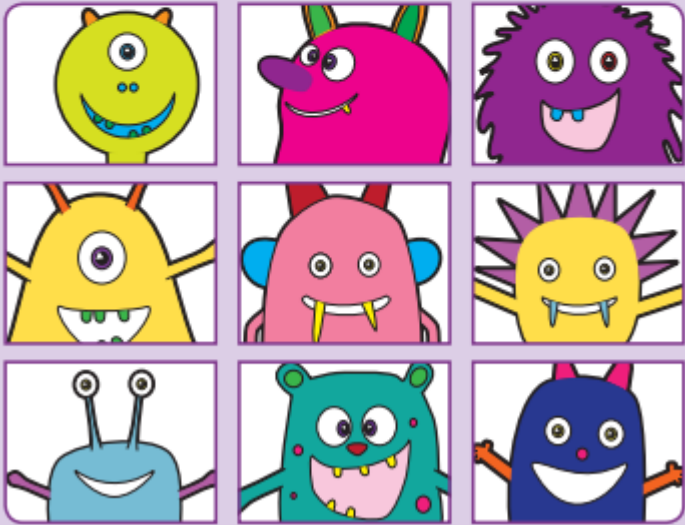

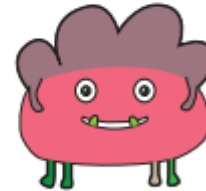

Please update changes in medication and personal change in circumstances in the office to ensure contact information is kept up-to-date.

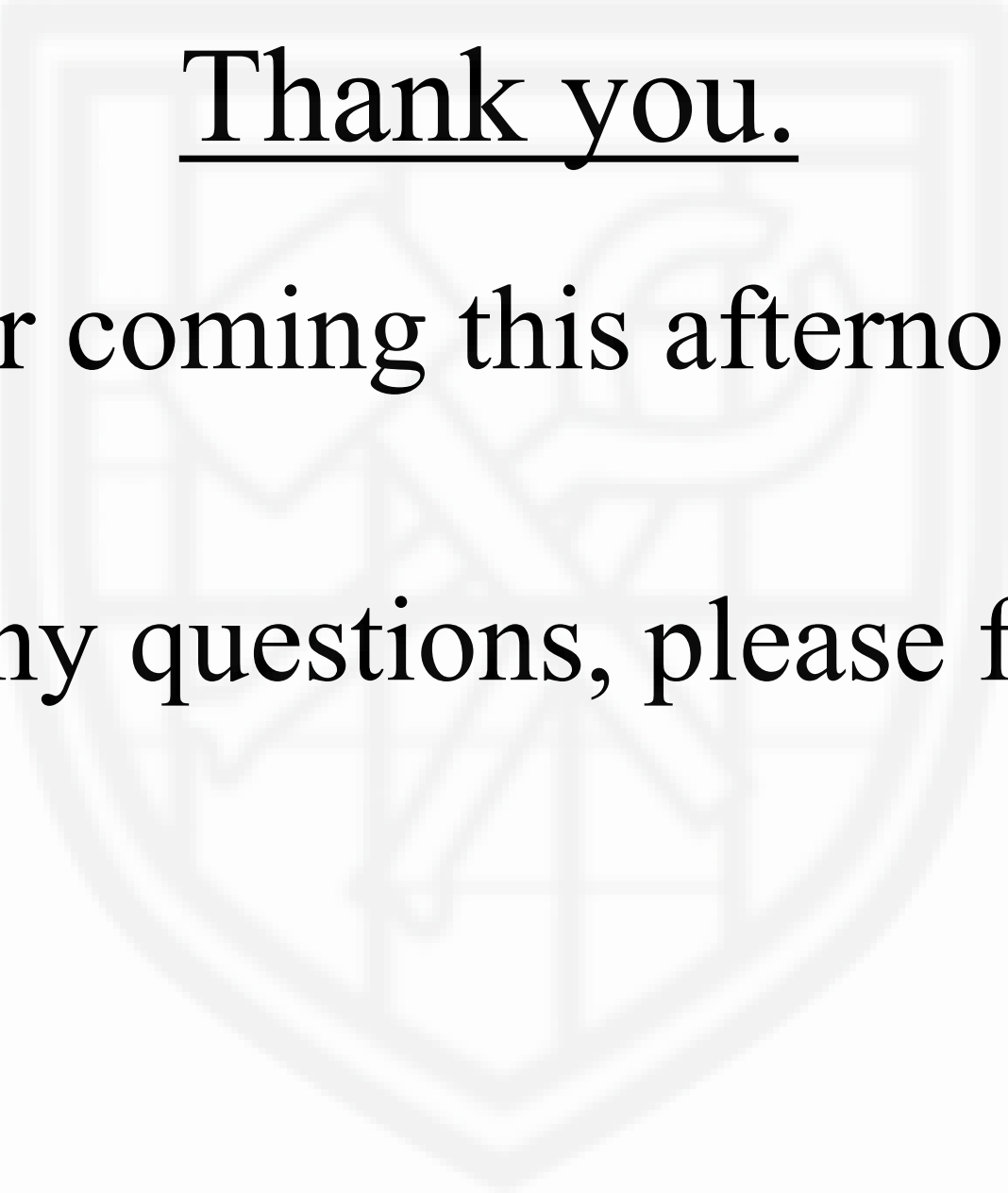
If you are now in receipt of income support, St Joseph's can apply for an additional grant to help your child via additional support – this is called Pupil Premium.
