Challenge: If you would like to extend this activity you can complete a book review with 3 reasons why someone may want to read the book you've just read.	A new spelling rule will be introduced weekly. Please ensure that spellings are practised frequently. Spelling tests will take place on Fridays. Challenge: If you would like to extend this activity you can write spelling sentences. This consists of writing a sentence including 1 spelling in each sentence. This is an excellent way for the children to implement their writing targets too.	Children should be accessing Times Tables Rock Stars every day for a minimum of 10 minutes per day.
