Include... ➤ What your home looks like ➤ What you ate ➤ Clothing and jewellery you wore ➤ Games you played ➤ The weather and environment <i>Challenge: If you would like to extend this activity you can include illustrations or labelled diagrams.</i>	Classification key ➤ Go outside (garden, park, or street) and find 5 different living things (plants, insects, birds or other animals). ➤ Draw or list them and then write two or three characteristics for each one (e.g. has wings, has leaves, has legs, has fur). ➤ Use a simple classification key such as yes/no questions to group them and help identify them. (Example start for your key: Does it have wings? Yes / No...Does it have leaves? Yes / No) Finish your work by writing one sentence explaining how your classification key helps you group living things.

Your report should be clearly organised with headings and include: 📍 Location – Where rainforests are found around the world 🌤️ Climate – What the weather is like in a rainforest 🦋 Animals – Examples of rainforest animals and their features 🌿 Plants – Types of plants that grow in rainforests and why they thrive there Remember to use expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and the correct pronouns.

Please ensure that spellings are practised frequently. Spelling tests will take place on Fridays. <i>Challenge: If you would like to extend this activity you can write spelling sentences. This consists of writing a sentence including 1 spelling in each sentence.
