Challenge: Include three personal goals for the year ahead.	School: Then and Now Interview an adult about their primary school days. Make a split-page picture showing three similarities or differences between school then and now. Challenge: Ask the adult to add one short memory or comment and their initials.

Use Times Table Rock Stars for short, regular practice. Keep your 2, 5 and 10 times tables fluent while learning the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Aim for 10 minutes a day.
